最后一点，第六个点: This small act of selflessness set off a chain reaction within our home; my siblings started sharing their own struggles too; we learned empathy towards one another like never before since we all realized how much more connected than ever everyone felt after hearing mom say those three magic sentences once again proving just how important listening really does matter especially when spoken by someone so dear!
